

HOW TO APPLY TO MJC

Seniors: If you're a graduating senior planning to attend MJC over the summer or in the fall, it's still not too late to apply. You MUST remember you will be required to take the Math & English placement tests. If you are currently taking classes at MJC, you MUST reapply for summer or fall admission. Before you can register for class(es), visit MJC website at www.mjc.edu and click on "Apply NOW" at the top of the page to apply online and set up your account. If you get stuck and need help applying, check out the step by step application instructions on the back of this form called "Graduating Seniors Applying Online to MJC." **Seniors**, remember you're applying as a high school graduate, NOT as a concurrently enrolled student.

Juniors, Sophomores, Freshmen: if you want to take a class at MJC over the summer or during the regular school year, you must first apply online at www.mjc.edu by setting up your account and registering as a concurrently enrolled student. In addition, you will need to download the "Advanced Admission" form (see instructions below for high school students who want to take MJC coursework). Once the "Advanced Admission" form is downloaded, printed and completely filled out (including course units, course name & course number) then it is the student's responsibility to get the middle of page 2 signed/approved by an administrator or counselor before student can submit the form to MJC admissions office for processing. Remember classes taken at MJC are free while you're still in high school!! **Suggested courses to take: Guidance 110, Guidance 111 (for students who don't know what to major in), Health 110, Music Appreciation 101, History 101 or 102, College Skills 100, Public Speaking 100 and various elective classes. To find MJC courses schedule (click on the "magnifying glass" in upper right hand corner of MJC homepage) to view what is being offered each semester.**

DIRECTIONS FOR HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS WHO WANT TO TAKE MJC COURSEWORK

1. Go to www.mjc.edu website. **NOTE:** make sure you've already completed & submitted your online application and created your account before proceeding to step #2.
2. Find [blue](#) student services tab and at drop down menu click on "Apply To MJC"
3. This will bring you to the application Information page
4. While on this page, scroll down until you get to heading "Special Part-Time Students (High School or Junior High students over the age of 14)"
5. Click on hyperlink "Advanced Admission Forms" and download a paper copy of special part-time petition application form. <https://www.mjc.edu/student-services/enrollment/admissions/applyforadmission.php> You can also pick up a hard copy of the form in the career center.
6. At the middle of page two, make sure to include the course number for the class **NOT** the section number.
7. Once everything is completely filled out (including course units, course name & course number), then return page 2 of the form to an administrator or counselor for approval/signature before **YOU** submit it to MJC enrollment service office for processing.

To view available classes at MJC:

1. Go to www.mjc.edu webpage
2. Click on the "magnifying glass" icon at the top right corner of the page
3. View available classes under fall, spring or summer term drop down menu

THINGS TO KEEP IN MIND

- ▶ Concurrently enrolled high school students can NOT be enrolled in more than 11 college credits
- ▶ To enroll in 12 or more units, concurrently enrolled high school students must have the written approval of their school district's Board of Trustees as well as the Modesto Junior College President.
- ▶ Concurrently enrolled high school students can only enroll in courses numbered from 50-299. **Make sure you fill in the course number for the class NOT the section number**
- ▶ English or Math placement test is required if a high school student decides to take a college English or Math course
- ▶ Lastly...Once all MJC paperwork is completely filled out by the student, then it is his/her responsibility to get an administrator or counselor signature for approval before taking it to MJC admissions office for submission.

Graduating Seniors Applying ONLINE to MJC- SUMMER/FALL Semester

Go to www.mjc.edu webpage

Click on "Apply Now" at the top of the page

At drop down menu click on Step 1 – “Apply Online”

Click on “Create An Account” (Old acct? Can't remember username? Create a new one)

When finished click “Create My Account”

Begin MJC application by clicking “New Application”
